BOARD OF SUPERVISORS  
MINUTES FEBRUARY 9, 2026

6:00PM

The February 2026 meeting of the Town of Two Rivers was called to order by Chairman Pohl. Supervisors Pohl, Petska, and Chase along with Clerk/Treasurer Timm were present. Also present: Fire Chief Leichtfuss, Highway Superintendent Kobes and Recycling Manager Wachholz. According to Chapter 19.84 of the Wisconsin Statutes, the meeting notices were posted in designated places and on the website. Confirmation from the Clerk that notices were properly posted was received.

The January 12, 2026, 2025, regular meeting minutes were approved as printed and reviewed with a motion from Petska and seconded by Chase, motion carried.

Chairman Pohl called three times for public input There being no public input, public input was closed.

General discussion was opened with regard to AI Data Center development in our area. Three residents, Elaine Steckler, Amy Loomis and Shane Loomis expressed their concerns along with providing documents and websites. They asked that the Town Supervisors continue to strive to at the least get a moratorium placed by the county to allow for research on these developments and also for the county to have time for zoning conditions and restrictions. Also battery and solar farms were discussed. The Town will keep pursuing options that we have in conjunction with the Town of Two Creeks and the Town of Mishicot. All three of us are under Manitowoc County Planning and Zoning.

The financials were reviewed and placed on file with a motion from Chase and seconded by Petska, motion carried.

Vouchers were reviewed and approved with a motion from Petska and seconded by Chase, motion carried.

Reports were given by Ambulance Board Member, Highway Superintendent, Fire Chief and Recycling Manager. Ambulance service board member reporting that the service is getting new volunteers and seems to be on a good track. Fire Chief discussed joint training that was held and will look into billing of jaws calls. A grant was received from Kelmann Restoration which will be used to purchase firefighters gloves.

Motion was made by Chase and seconded by Petska to adjourn regular meeting. Motion carried and meeting was adjourned at 6:41pm.
